

PROJECT PROFILE: Edina Public Schools

Location: Edina

The Edina school district project is a great example of how BR's capabilities span beyond asphalt paving. As general contractor, we coordinated underground utilities, electrical work, tree removal, 6,700 LF of curb and gutter, and 32,200 SF of sidewalk for multiple parking lots. BR's crew performed nearly 7,000 CY of removal and excavating, paved 4,800 ton of hot mix asphalt and prepped nearly 10,000 SY for landscaping.
