PROJECT PROFILE: City of Richfield

Location: Southeast Richfield

This past February, Bituminous Roadways, Inc. bid on a large mill and overlay project for the City of Richfield. After receiving the contract, work began May 1st on approximately 16.75 miles of streets in the southeast part of the city. A majority of the work was mill and overlay, however, a small portion of deteriorated base needed repair before paving. In the end, we will use approximately 44,000 tons of asphalt to create smooth roads for City of Richfield residents.
